## HOW TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION (details of these steps follow)

1. Register at [applyforgrants.calfund.org](http://applyforgrants.calfund.org)
2. Log in and select the **Scholarship Application**
3. Fill out the application and click **Select Scholarships**
4. Complete application
5. Submit application

### 1. Registration

**Founded in 1998, the Asian Pacific American Bar Association of Los Angeles County (APABA) adopted the following multifaceted mission:**

1. to establish a broad base of membership that is reflective of the ethnic and cultural diversity of the Asian Pacific Islander American (APIA) community in the greater Los Angeles Area;
2. to provide a vehicle and forum for the unified expression of opinions and positions by the Association upon current social, political, economic, legal or other matters or events of concern to the members;
3. to foster the exchange of ideas and information amongst and between Association members and other members of the legal profession, the judiciary and the community;
4. to encourage and promote the professional growth of the members;
5. to provide an opportunity for fellowship among the Association's members;
6. to develop and encourage inter-cooperation with and between other bar organizations, especially other minority bar associations; and
7. to provide coordinated service to the community-at-large as well as to the local APIA community.

The APABA Fellowship will be awarded to a law student who demonstrates leadership potential, maturity, and responsibility, as well as a commitment to making a contribution to the APIA community. The law student must find a position in a nonprofit or governmental public interest organization that serves the APIA community in Los Angeles County for at least an 8-week period during the summer. The law student must be supervised by a licensed attorney. Positions at the office of a public defender, district attorney, or a judge do not qualify for the fellowship. Applicants must have secured an eligible position at the time of their application
